### **A. What is The 2024 APHNI International Student Photo Competition?**

### **B. Theme**

“The Evolution of Health Care Delivery and Navigation on Nutrition, Maternal and Child Health and Chronic Diseases”

### **C. Sub Themes**

1. Maternal-child Health and Nutrition
2. Degenerative and Non-Communicable Disease
3. Health Technologies for Health Improvement

### **D. Competition Category**

Competition Category is “Reportage Photo”. The purpose of the reportage photo is to tell a story through a photograph that truthfully and accurately captures the reality of a situation, event, or issue. The photograph should be candid. Either posed or manipulated photos are not permitted.

### **E. Rules**

1. Rules of Reportage Photo
  - a. Must be in .jpeg or .jpg file format.
  - b. Taken by the entrant with any kind of digital camera.
  - c. Be a fair and truthful representation of reality and the subject and/or scene, which has not been significantly manipulated or altered. Editorial alterations to photos (e.g., colour, contrast, definition, shadows, highlights, cropping, levelling, etc.) are permissible if the alterations do not alter the reality of the subjects or objects of the photo.
2. All entries must have an English title of no more than 140 characters.
3. All entries must have an English description/caption of no more than 100 words or 700 characters. The description should explain the matter of nutrition, maternal and child health and chronic diseases. It may include scientific facts, information, or inspiration associated with the subject matter captured in the photo.
4. All entries must be technically and artistically of good quality. This includes composition, lighting, colour, sharpness, and subject.
5. All entries should be relevant to the designated theme/topic.
6. All photos and captions must not have been published or awarded by any competition.

7. All photos must be original work, taken by the entrants. No third party may own or control any materials the photo contains. The photo must not infringe upon the trademark, copyright, moral rights, intellectual rights, or rights of privacy of any entity or person. AI-generated images are not permitted. The organizer has the right to remove or disqualify any relevant entry, if necessary.
8. Entrants will retain full ownership of the copyright for each entry that they submit to the organizer. By entering the competition, all entrants grant to the organizer the right to use, publish, and exhibit their photos either in whole or in part, and use or edit their captions for educational, marketing, and promotional purposes in any media, such as printing, websites, and exhibitions (without notice and with no fees for any of the above uses). While we make every effort to credit photographers, including in printed reproductions of their works, we cannot guarantee that every broadcast use of the photos will include the photographers' names.

**F. Application Period**

1. 20 Oct 2024 (Sun) - 12 Nov 2024 (Sun), 05:00 GMT (12:00 AM WIB).
2. Submission will be judged between 13 – 19 November 2024.

November 20th, 2024 at the APHNI Conference and via APHNI website.

**H. Eligibility**

The competition is open to all national and international undergraduate or master students.

**I. Submission Fee**

None. The competition is free of charge.

**J. Awards**

1. 1<sup>st</sup> Winner: 750,000 IDR
2. 2<sup>nd</sup> Winner: 500,000 IDR
3. 3<sup>rd</sup> Winner: 250,000 IDR

**K. Research Poster Scoring Criteria**

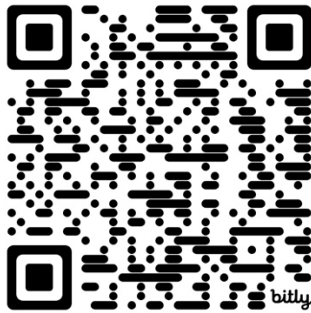
The highest score for each entry is 100 points, of which 60% (60 points) for the photograph and 40% (40 points) for the accompanying title and description, respectively.

1. Photograph (60 points)
  - a. The portrayal of ideas, concepts, or messages relevant to the competition theme/topic.
  - b. The quality and artistic value of the photograph. This includes composition lighting, colour, sharpness, and subject.
  - c. The technique(s) employed to capture or create the photograph.
2. Accompanying texts (40 points)

- a. The portrayal of ideas, concepts, or messages relevant to the competition theme/topic.
- b. The construction of the messages in cooperation with the photograph, style, and expression
